### Overview:

A major spending stage of Prana's research and development activities has now been completed. Accordingly it is anticipated that there will be a significant reduction in monthly cash outflows over the following periods. The company's financial reserves are sufficient to sustain its ongoing activities for a period of at least 18 months. Recently the company announced an agreement for an additional \$7.5 million in research funding from Schering A.G. Germany to fund and licence discoveries on diagnostics and new drug targets separate to Prana's Metal Protein Attenuating Compounds ("MPACs"). The company will be focussing on the development of the new Schering projects together with commercialisation of its existing MPAC compounds.
